AlphaMundi Group Ltd (“AMG”) is a commercial entity based in Switzerland and exclusively dedicated to **impact investing: profitable investments that generate substantial net social and environmental benefits to society**. Since 2009, AMG provides debt and equity financing to scalable impact ventures in Latin America and Africa in sectors such as inclusive finance, sustainable food and renewable energy. AMG is currently investing out of its debt impact fund SocialAlpha, domiciled in Luxembourg. AMG also manages co-investments for its fund investors and third parties.

Job Description

The Fellow will be working for AMG headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland, providing support on a variety of activities related to partnerships, fundraising, marketing, and market-building activities. Responsibilities will involve:

- AMG fundraising;
- AMG market building activities and partnerships;
- Liaising with AMG teams in Africa and Latin America to produce marketing and investor reporting materials;

Candidates should have the following qualifications:

- Bachelor’s degree and/ or Master’s degree and/ or ongoing studies in a relevant field (finance, business, economics, development studies, sustainability studies);
- Demonstrated passion for sustainable development and sustainable investing;
- Aptitude for analytical and critical thinking and attention to detail;
- Excellent oral and writing skills in English; fluency in French, German and/or Spanish;
- Very good Microsoft Office skills and a good sense for visual design;
- Strong interpersonal skills with a good aptitude for proactive communication and transparency;
- Capacity to work autonomously and at flexible hours when work demands it.

The Fellow should be available on a full-time basis for at least 6 months. The Fellow will be expected to work at our Geneva office 1-2 days per week, however, we offer flexible working conditions. The Fellowship is a learning and career development opportunity for young

professionals and will be compensated with a monthly gross salary of CHF 1'000, in addition to business expenses.

The Fellow will work alongside AMG's entrepreneurial and motivated team of highly qualified investment professionals, for an organisation of international scope and with an impact-driven mission aligned on the Sustainable Development Goals. The Fellow will also acquire practical experience working in impact investing, which is quickly gaining importance within the broader field of sustainable investing.
