Organization

AlphaMundi Group Ltd is a commercial entity based in Switzerland and exclusively dedicated to Impact Investing: profitable investments that generate substantial net benefits to society. Since 2009, AlphaMundi provides debt and equity financing to scalable impact ventures in Latin America and Africa, across Sustainable Development Goals sectors such as Finance, Food and Energy.

AlphaMundi is currently investing in two funds: 1) its impact debt fund, SocialAlpha Investment Fund (SAIF), domiciled in Luxembourg with a Delaware feeder for US investors, investing in Latin America and Africa and 2) a debt and equity fund, AlphaJiri, that invests exclusively in Africa. AlphaMundi also manages co-investments for SAIF investors and third parties. In 2017, AlphaMundi began integrating gender analysis throughout its activities, promoting diversity at the management company, portfolio company, and beneficiary levels.

In 2024, AlphaMundi is set to launch its first Equity Fund in Latin America, with a focus on climate action and social inclusion, incorporating a transversal gender lens strategy. The fund aims to reach a target size of USD 60M and will invest in early-stage tech-companies in Colombia, Mexico, Peru, and Chile.

Job Description

AlphaMundi's Investment Manager will be based in Bogotá, Colombia, and actively support the team in Latin America with all aspects of the investment process from pipeline sourcing to diligence and investment monitoring. SocialAlpha currently has 16 portfolio companies located in Mexico, Ecuador, Peru & Colombia. Frequent travel throughout the region will be required.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Participate in all parts of the investment process including but not limited to: conducting detailed market and country analysis, performing due diligence on pipeline companies, preparing investment memos and recommendations, and contributing to investment decisions;
- Help monitor the current investment portfolio, and provide management support to portfolio companies through the holding period to actively manage and mitigate risks;

- Help maintain, prepare, and present detailed investment documentation on the Latin American portfolio companies for AlphaMundi management, the Investment Committee, and the Board;
- Support AlphaMundi activities in the region, and develop strong relations with portfolio and pipeline companies, co-investors, and institutional partners.

Candidates should have the following qualifications:

- 4-year degree in a relevant field (finance, business, economics) with master's degree or CFA preferred;
- At least 7-10 years of working experience, including 4 years of financial and risk and investment analysis, preferably in Venture Capital or investment banking;
- Desirable experience in the Impact Investing field, a Development Finance Institution, a Microfinance Fund, or a leading firm in Private Equity, investment banking, or consulting;
- Strong financial acumen including accounting, valuation skills, and Excel financial modeling;
- Knowledge and operational experience in fintech, microfinance, renewable energy, recycling, and/or agriculture, and dedication to sustainable development;
- Excellent writing skills in both English and Spanish;
- Strong interpersonal skills with a good aptitude for pro-active communication and transparency, patience, and perseverance;
- Entrepreneurial team player with the ability to work independently in Colombia;
- Being from or living for the last 3+ years in Latin America;
- Willingness to travel throughout Latin America
